- FIRST**—Amendment to Article 13 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the construction and maintenance of good roads and the supplying of coal to the people of the state from the lands belonging to the state.
- SECOND**—Amendment to Article 21 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the irrigation of agricultural lands.
- THIRD**—Amendment to Article 11 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to revenue and finance.
- FOURTH**—Amendment of Section 1 of Article 13 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to rural credits.
- FIFTH**—Amendment to Section 2 of Article 23 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the holding of a constitutional convention.
- SIXTH**—Amendment to Section 1 of Article 7 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the right of suffrage to women.
- SEVENTH**—Amendment to Article 24 of the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, relating to the prohibition of the intoxicating liquor traffic.
- EIGHTH**—Amendment to Section 9 of Article 8 of the Constitution of South Dakota, relating to the leasing of school lands.
- NINTH**—Amendment to Section 2 of Article 21 of the Constitution of South Dakota, relating to the regulation of salaries for all elective state officers.

INITIATIVE AND REFERRED LAWS

- FIRST**—An Act to provide for Regulation of Political Party Transactions.
- SECOND**—An Act relating to the Issuance of Permits for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.
- THIRD**—An Act providing for the Establishment of a Department of Banking and Finance.
- FOURTH**—An Act to Create a State Banking Board.
- FIFTH**—An Act relating to a Five-Sixths Jury.
