### **Funds as of 04/30/15**

- \$9,548,614.10 overall
- \$2,560,375.87 in County-held funds
  - Reimbursements being reviewed: Brookings, Custer, Davison, McCook, Todd, and Tripp.
- \$6,988,238.23 in State-held funds

### **Interest Earned**

- \$109,940.34 in SFY14
- \$178,783.14 in SFY13
- \$297,486.40 in SFY12

### **Annual Maintenance Agreements**

- TotalVote (BPro, Inc.)
  - \$49,500 every year
  - The sales from voter lists help offset this cost
- iOASIS (Everyone Counts, Inc.)
  - \$50,000 every two years
  - Originated from a FVAP grant
- Vote605 (GCR, Inc.)
  - \$20,000 every two years

### Polling place accessibility grants

#### **Funds available**

- \$309,593.65
  - Brown County= \$114,750.00
  - Stanley County= \$49,637.70
  - Walworth County= \$2,326.48
- \$257,629.47 left
- September 30, 2015
  - Need to spend \$109,593.65

#### **Project examples**

- Automatic door openers, elevator, chair lift, new ramps
- Replace counter height desk with a lower, more handicap accessible desk
- Handicap pull handles

#### **2014 Polling Place Accessibility Survey**

- Main entrance inaccessible
- No accessible parking signs
- No low tables for wheelchair access
- No privacy when using AutoMARK
- Main door heavy to pull
- Unmarked accessible entrance
- Path to front entrance not clear
- Inaccessible AutoMARK, not enough room
- Space tight for wheelchairs
- No signs from accessible entrance to the voting area

#### **Process**

- Submit Pre-completion Application
- Receive approval
- Conduct project
- Submit Completion Application
- Receive reimbursement
  - 75% if work is done at a courthouse
  - 100% if work is done at a non-courthouse polling place
