Whereas, On July 27, 1953, the United States, North Korea, and China signed an armistice ending the war but failing to bring about permanent peace; and,

Whereas, The Department of Defense has established a 60th Anniversary of the Korean War Commemoration Committee to thank and honor all veterans of the Korean War; and,

Whereas, The Committee is committed to locating and recognizing Korean War Veterans. They began their commemoration period in 2010, continuing until 2013 to coincide with the 60th Anniversary of the Korean War; and,


