Whereas, Farmers markets offer producers across the state a chance to participate in their community activities and to enhance perceptions of wholesome life and sound agricultural practices; and,


Whereas, Local governments, community leaders, and private businesses have welcomed farmers markets as a way of keeping their communities healthy; and,
