Dear Joyce,

As Chris Nelson requested in a conversation with Eric Bogue yesterday, following are the irregularities as found in the process of canvassing.

1. McIntosh Precinct
 - a) The Thune/Johnson race totals were higher on the Recap sheet than shown on the pollbook.
 - b) The Hanson/Nelson race totals were higher on the Recap sheet than shown on the pollbook.
 - c) The totals shown for Eric Bogue were higher on the Recap sheet than shown on the pollbook.
2. Morrystown Precinct
 - a) The totals for Constitutional Amendment B were higher on the Recap sheet than shown on the pollbook.
3. Archambault precinct: the Recap sheets were not sealed within the official envelope but were clipped to the outside.
4. South McLaughlin City Precinct
 - a) No totals were entered on either the Recap sheets or on the pollbook pages for any race or ballot question. Hash marks were there; no totals
 - b) The totals shown for Dick Butler were less on the Recap sheet than shown on the pollbook.
5. Little Eagle Precinct
 - a) The number of hash marks on the pollbook did not match the numerical total recorded.
 - b) The back of the pollbook was not completed.
6. Kenel Precinct
 - a) There were more hash marks for Jim Abbott on the Recap sheet than on the pollbook.
 - b) There were more hash marks for Constitutional Amendment B on Recap sheet than shown on pollbook.

7. Bullhead Precinct

- a) The total number of hash marks shown on the Recap sheets did not match the number shown on the pollbook for most of the political races; the numbers are shown below:
