I write to acknowledge receipt of your documentation to support the Regents' Online Degree Program (RODP) in which 19 TBR institutions will offer collaborative online courses and degree programs beginning this fall. Participating institutions are: Austin Peay State University, East Tennessee State University, Middle Tennessee State University, Tennessee State University, Tennessee Technological University, The University of Memphis, Chattanooga State Technical Community College, Cleveland State Community College, Columbia State Community College, Dyersburg State Community College, Jackson State Community College, Motlow State Community College, Nashville State Technical Institute, Northeast State Technical Community College, Pellissippi State Technical Community College, Roane State Community College, Southwest Tennessee Community College, Volunteer State Community College, and Walters State Community College. Support for this initiative was documented from the respective campuses, the Tennessee Board of Regents, and the Tennessee Higher Education Commission.

As I understand it, initial program offerings will include: (1) the BS or BLS in Interdisciplinary Studies; (2) the BS or BPS in Professional Studies with concentrations in Organizational Leadership and Information Technology; (3) the AA and AS in General Studies; and (4) the AAS in Professional Studies with a concentration in Information Technology. Furthermore, the primary target audience will include working adults who have completed some collegiate work up to an associate's degree but less than the baccalaureate degree.

Interactive, online courses will be offered in an asynchronous format each semester comparable to campus-based courses at each location. RODP students will choose a home campus, however, course delivery may emanate from either of the participating institutions. It appears that programmatic requirements, student support services, faculty training and infrastructure are in

place to support this initiative. Library resources are available through a Virtual Library supplemented by cooperative efforts such as the Tennessee Academic Library Collaborative and the Tennessee Electronic Library.


Furthermore, administrative oversight will be coordinated by a team at the TBR central office and campus personnel. Technical assistance will be provided by Eduprise, an e-learning service provider, using WebCT software. The Board of Regents provided start-up funding; projections are that the RODP will be self-supporting after 2005.

Based on the quality of your submission, I am pleased to accept your documentation and incorporate this development in the scope of accreditation for each of the 19 participating institutions. I have also authorized a Substantive Change Committee to assess the RODP within the next 12 months to ensure continued institutional compliance with the *Criteria for Accreditation*. Dr. Gerald D. Lord and Dr. W. Donald Crump here at the Commission will contact your staff later to arrange for the visit. We appreciate your check for \$1900 to assist in defraying the added cost associated with staff review of the substantive change prospectus.

We also received your letter regarding the expansion of the mission of Nashville State Technical Institute to that of a comprehensive community college. As you know, a change in the mission of a member institution constitutes a substantive change which requires prior approval. You are asked to submit a prospectus which addresses this request at least three months prior to implementation. Please refer to our website (www.sacscoc.org) and click on 'Commission Publications' followed by 'Revised Substantive Change Policies and Procedures.' Guidelines concerning the prospectus can be found in Appendix B. Should you have questions concerning this matter, please refer them to Dr. John O. Your assessment of need for the RODP program was thorough and compelling. We noted that 98 percent of the faculty who will provide instruction in 2001-02 are full-time. Please accept our best wishes for success as you launch this initiative.
