Whereas, The Nursing Student Association of South Dakota provides education opportunities for student nurses through leadership, education, scholarship, legislature, and career networking; and,


Whereas, Nursing students promote health and wellness in addition to serving as client advocates; and,

Whereas, Future nurses will be employed in a variety of health settings to meet the needs of the people of this state:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim February 24, 2012, as

NURSING STUDENT DAY


in South Dakota.
