
Whereas, Shirley has three children, eight grandchildren, and seven great grandchildren, most of which live in South Dakota; and,

Whereas, Shirley has been a dedicated and hard-working South Dakotan for the past 50 years:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim April 1, 2012, as


