
Whereas, The Power Team, as incredible drug free athletes, will be in 13-15 of our South Dakota schools bringing a positive message of inspiration and motivation; and,

Whereas, It is fitting and proper to give these men and women the opportunity to positively affect South Dakotans in this positive manner:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim March 21, 2012, as

POWER TEAM DAY


in South Dakota.
