Whereas, His loyalty and leadership have made him a cornerstone in the United States Air Force and this country; and,


Whereas, Master Sergeant Elliott continues to give of himself; and,

Whereas, It is fitting and proper as Governor to commend Master Sergeant David Elliott for over 22 years of dedicated and outstanding service to this state and country:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim July 1, 2012 as
