Whereas, Studies have demonstrated that most Americans do not have adequate savings to meet major emergencies, let alone accumulate enough savings for retirement; and,

Whereas, Seventy-two percent of Americans would find it difficult to meet current expenses if their paycheck were delayed a week, making it important to further facilitate the increasing trend of long-term personal savings; and,

Whereas, Building wealth and reducing debt allow individuals and families to meet goals such as having an emergency fund, buying a home, starting a business, financing a college education, and having enough money to live comfortably during later years; and,

Whereas, Members of the South Dakota Jump\$tart Coalition for Financial Literacy provide financial education, teacher support, and financial counseling to serve the financial education needs of South Dakota adults and youth; and,


