
*Whereas*, Correctional employees perform their duties with pride, perseverance, and professionalism in a difficult and dangerous field; and,


*Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard*, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim May 6-12, 2012, as


in South Dakota, and I urge all citizens to recognize and appreciate the efforts of the men and women who work in the corrections field.
