
*Whereas*, It is fitting and proper as Governor to recognize Dennis for his service to his clients, the city of Mitchell, and the state of South Dakota:

*Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard*, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim May 1, 2012, as


