*Whereas*, Luz supplied the fruits of her family garden for those at the Mansion, as well as her plants, and special gifts to the families; and,


*Whereas*, It is fitting and proper as Governor to make special note of an outstanding South Dakotan to honor and celebrate her on this momentous occasion:
