Whereas, Through their lifelong dedication to the values of caring and sharing, Arthur and Ordia have helped make South Dakota a great place to live and work; and,


Whereas, Arthur and Ordia will celebrate their 70th Anniversary with all the good wishes, fanfare, and celebration such a milestone warrants; and,

Whereas, It is altogether fitting and proper that the Governor of South Dakota recognizes and commemorates the memorable occasions in the lives of the state's outstanding citizens:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim June 7, 2012, as
