Whereas, Through a promise of lifelong dedication to the values of caring and sharing, Traci and Tyler will help make South Dakota a great place to live and work; and,


Whereas, Traci and Tyler will celebrate their wedding with a dinner and dance with friends and family on June 9, 2012; and,
