Whereas, His loyalty and leadership have made him a cornerstone in the Armed Forces of this country; and,


Whereas, Staff Sergeant Fode continues to give of himself; and,

Whereas, It is fitting and proper as Governor to commend Staff Sergeant Troy Fode for over 22 years of dedicated and outstanding service to this state and country:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim September 1, 2012, as


in South Dakota, and I join with his family and friends in wishing him well in his retirement and thanking him for his service to the state of South Dakota and to the United States of America.
