Whereas, His loyalty and leadership have made him a cornerstone in the Armed Forces of this country; and,


Whereas, Chief Warrant Officer Five Ewert continues to give of himself; and,


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim September 30, 2012, as

in South Dakota, and I join with his family and friends in wishing him well in his retirement and thanking him for his service to the state of South Dakota and to the United States of America.


