Whereas, Lynn will be missed for his likeable personality, relaxed approach to life, and unique humor; and,


Whereas, Lynn plans to spend his retirement catching up on his fishing and spending time goose hunting with his chocolate lab, Bailey; and,

Whereas, It is fitting and proper as Governor to recognize the contributions of Lynn Coonrod to the state of South Dakota during his many years of employment with state government:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim August 23, 2012, as

LYNN COONROD DAY


in South Dakota, and I join with his colleagues and friends in wishing him a fulfilling and happy retirement.
