*Whereas*, During his time with the Department of Transportation, Craig been successful in obtaining several million dollars in grants and implementing a very successful scenic byway program; and,



*Whereas*, It is fitting and proper as Governor to recognize the contributions of Craig McIntyre to the state of South Dakota during his many years of employment with state government:


*Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard*, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim August 23, 2012, as


in South Dakota, and I join with his colleagues and friends in wishing him a fulfilling and happy retirement.
