
Whereas, Nancy has had an active family life, raising three children and loving and caring for her grandchildren; and,

Whereas, It is fitting and proper to honor this outstanding South Dakotan on the occasion of her retirement:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim November 23, 2012, as
