*Whereas*, Gloria continues to give of herself; and,


*Whereas*, Gloria's dedication to our service members, their families, and our state's veterans has made her a valuable asset to this state and country; and,

*Whereas*, It is fitting and proper as Governor to commend Gloria for her dedicated and outstanding service to this state and country:


*Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard*, Governor of the state of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim March 24, 2011, as

*GLORIA K. DOOHEN DAY*


in South Dakota, and I join with her family and friends, in wishing her well and thanking her for her service to the state of South Dakota and the United States.
