
Whereas, The South Dakota State University Engineering Extension Office and staff were previously recognized with a National OSHA "OSCAR" Award; and,

Whereas, James will officially retire on March 21, 2011, and family and friends will join him in a retirement reception on March 17, 2011:


Now, Therefore, I, Dennis Daugaard, Governor of the State of South Dakota, do hereby proclaim March 21, 2011, as

JAMES D. MANNING DAY


in South Dakota, and I join with his family, colleagues, students, and friends in wishing him a fulfilling and happy retirement.
