Dear Sir or Madam:

We have received your telephone inquiry regarding your organization's federal tax exempt status and name change. Please note we have corrected our records to reflect the name as shown above. We have recorded this change as part of your permanent record. This letter will take the place of the copy you requested.

Our records indicate your organization is exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and it is not a private foundation, within the meaning of 509(a) of the Code, because your organization is described in sections 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i). Your organization is included in the group ruling issued to the United States Catholic Conference. The United States Catholic Conference is listed in Publication 78. Donors may deduct contributions to your organization under section 170 of the code.

As your organization is included in a group ruling, there is not an individual exemption letter for it. The group exemption letter applies to all of the subordinate organizations on whose behalf the United States Catholic Conference has applied for recognition of exemption.
