

Preventive Health Strategies ("PHS"), a recognized 501(c)3 organization for charitable purposes organized under the laws of South Dakota, wishes to conduct a state-wide raffle as permitted under SDCL 22-25-25. The raffle will provide funding for charitable activities within the strategic mission of PHS.

Ticket sales for the raffle will begin thirty days following the requisite filing of notice with the State of South Dakota. The minimum number of tickets to be sold is 500. If the minimum number of tickets has been sold by February 14, 2012, a drawing will be conducted in Sioux Falls, SD on February 14, 2012 to award the prize. If the minimum number of tickets has not been sold by the drawing date, the drawing will be postponed until such a date as the minimum has been achieved. The rules and conditions of the raffle will be printed on every raffle ticket sold.

The winner of the PHS raffle will be awarded title in fee simple absolute to 159.7 +/- acres of prime South Dakota farmland. The land is described as Aurora Township, NE 1/4, Section 6-103-64. The approximate value of the land is at least \$366,100. The land was donated to PHS with the specific intent of being a raffle fundraising prize.
