Secretary of State Urges Voters to Turn to Trusted Sources for General Election Information

(Pierre, S.D.) – As South Dakotans prepare to head to the polls Tuesday, November 5th for the 2024 General Election, Secretary of State Monae L. Johnson urges voters to turn to verified and trusted sources of election information. Reliable sources of election information include the Secretary of State's Office and county auditors. Before heading to the polls, we ask voters to verify their polling place by contacting their county auditor or by accessing the Voter Information Portal (VIP) on the Secretary of State's website at https://vip.sdsos.gov/VIPLogin.aspx.

Voters are encouraged to read the Secretary of State's <u>Guide to Understanding Secure</u> <u>Elections in South Dakota</u> to learn more about the measures being taken to ensure the integrity of our elections. In addition, voters should also consult the Secretary of State's website at <u>www.sdsos.gov</u> or contact their county auditor at https://vip.sdsos.gov/CountyAuditors.aspx if they have any questions.
