Secretary of State Urges Voters to Turn to Trusted Sources for Primary Election Information

(Pierre, S.D.) – As South Dakotans prepare to head to the polls tomorrow for the 2024 Primary Election, Secretary of State Monae L. Johnson urges voters to turn to verified and trusted sources of election information. Reliable sources of election information include the Secretary of State’s Office and local county auditors.

Voters may verify their voter registration information, polling place location, whether they have already requested an absentee ballot, and check the status of their absentee ballot by contacting their county auditor or searching the Voter Information Portal (**VIP**) on the Secretary of State’s website: <https://vip.sdsos.gov/VIPLogin.aspx>.
