Dear Rev. Speas:

It is my pleasure to give you official word that, at its February 1994 meeting, the AABC Commission on Accreditation took action to grant initial accreditation to Kentucky Mountain Bible College.

In taking its action, the Commission requests that a progress report be submitted for its consideration in 1996 addressing the college's progress on all recommendations of the Evaluation Team Report. A supplementary evaluation visit for the purpose of verifying the progress that has been made on the team recommendations and suggestions, and the weaknesses identified by the self-study report will be conducted on your campus by a representative of AABC during year three.
