

## 2018 LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATE Signature Requirements

- **Constitution and Libertarian** signature counts follow new party signature counts per SDCL 12-6-7.
- **Republican and Democratic:** 50 signatures or 1% of the vote for their party's gubernatorial candidate in the district in the 2014 election, whichever is less (SDCL 12-6-7.1)
- **Independent:** signatures equal to 1% of the total vote for Governor in 2014 within the District (SDCL 12-7-1)
- **(VC) : Legislative District contains a County that uses Vote Centers**

### VOTE CENTER COUNTIES

Below are Legislative Districts that contain a County that uses Vote Centers. As a result, signature requirements are calculated differently per SDCL 12-6-7. In 2016, the Vote Center (VC) counties within these Legislative Districts printed ballots by *Ballot Style*. In 2018, these same counties intend to print their ballots by *Ballot Style*.

Legislative Districts 1, 2, 3: VC county is Brown

Legislative District 23: VC county is Potter

Legislative Districts 4 & 7: VC county is Brookings

Legislative District 24: VC counties are Sully and Hughes

Legislative District 18: VC county is Yankton

SDCL 12-6-7...If a county uses vote centers **and** does not print ballots by precinct, signature requirements for both partisan and independent candidates are:

- (1) Fifty signatures for a legislative candidate whose district either in whole or in part includes that county;
- (2) Thirty signatures for a county candidate;
- (3) Fifteen signatures for county commissioner district candidates;
- (4) Five signatures for a new party legislative candidate whose district either in whole or in part includes that county;
- (5) Five signatures for a new party county candidate; or
- (6) Three signatures for a new party county commissioner district candidate
