



Absentee Voting in the June 5, 2018 Primary Election in South Dakota

Which ballot does an absentee voter receive?

Democratic Voter

- Voter marks DEM ballot – receives DEM ballot if there is one
- If there is not a DEM ballot for that voter, they will be given the Non-political ballot

Republican Voter

- Voter marks REP ballot – receives REP ballot
- The Republican ballot is the only ballot a Republican voter will be given

Libertarian & Constitution Voters

- Voter will only be given the Non-political ballot

NPA/IND

- Voter marks Non-political ballot - receives the Non-political ballot
- Voter marks DEM ballot – voter receives DEM ballot if there is one
- If there is not a Dem ballot the voter will receive the Non-political ballot
- If no ballot selection – voter receives Non-political ballot

Voters Registered as Other

- Voter will only be given the Non-political ballot
