## CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

- A. The following amendment to the Constitution is submitted to a vote of the people by the Legislature.

A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing and agreeing to an amendment of Article V, section 7, of the Constitution of the state of South Dakota, relating to the appointment of Supreme Court justices and circuit court judges.

- B. The following amendment to the Constitution is submitted to a vote of the people by initiative of the voters pursuant to the Constitution.

AN INITIATED PROPOSAL To amend the Constitution of the state of South Dakota by adding a new section to Article VI relating to real property tax limitation. (Dakota Proposition)

- C. The following amendment to the Constitution is submitted to a vote of the people by initiative of the voters pursuant to the Constitution.

AN INITIATED PROPOSAL To amend Article III, section 1, of the Constitution relating to prohibiting the Legislature from substantially changing or re-enacting any initiated or referred law enacted or defeated by a vote of the people.

- D. The following amendment to the Constitution is submitted to a vote of the people by the Legislature.

A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing and agreeing to an amendment to Article III, section 1, of the Constitution of the state of South Dakota, relating to legislative prerogative to amend initiated or referred laws approved by the electors.

- E. The following amendment to the Constitution is submitted to a vote of the people by the Legislature.

A JOINT RESOLUTION, Proposing and agreeing to a new section and amendments to sections 6 and 7 of Article III of the Constitution of the state of South Dakota relating to the length of the legislative session and the powers of the Legislature.

## REFERRED LAWS AND INITIATED MEASURES

1. The following law has been passed by the Legislature and signed by the Governor, but did not go into effect because a referendum petition containing signatures of five per cent of the voters of the state has been filed, in accordance with the Constitution, and these laws will not become operative until approved by the people.

AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to Allow the Hunting of Mourning Doves.

2. The following measure has not been passed by the Legislature, and the Legislature is neither recommending nor condemning it. It has been placed upon the ballot by initiative petitions containing signatures of five per cent of the voters and filed in accordance with the Constitution, and this proposed measure will not become law unless approved by the people.

AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act relating to regulation of uranium mining, the construction of nuclear power plants, and the disposal of nuclear waste.
