

## SUPPLEMENTAL STATEMENT

## Candidates, Political Action, Political Party or Ballot Question Committees

<u>Who files this statement</u>: State law requires that if any candidate committee for statewide office (legislative candidates do not file supplemental statements), political action committee, ballot question committee, or political party receives a contribution of **five hundred dollars or more within the fourteen days immediately prior to an election** for which a campaign finance disclosure form may be filed, a supplemental statement shall be filed within forty-eight hours of receipt of the contribution (<u>SDCL 12-27-28</u>). If the contribution is received on or after Election Day, a supplemental statement is not required to be submitted.

<u>Deadline to file:</u> Within 48 hours of the time that the contribution was received if it was received within the 14 days immediately prior to an election.

File with: The Secretary of State except local political committees file with their local election official.
