Johnson, has reviewed "An Amendment to the South Dakota Constitution Requiring Legislative Changes to Voter-Approved Initiated Measures, for Seven Years After Approval, to Pass by a Three-Fourths Vote of the Legislature and be Approved by a Vote of the People."

In accordance with SDCL 12-13-26 & 26.1 this office certifies that said initiated Constitutional Amendment embraces only one subject and is an amendment to the Constitution under S.D. Const., Art. XXIII, § 1. Secretary Johnson further states that said initiated Constitutional Amendment is not a revision under S.D. Const., Art. XXIII, § 2.
