

This letter is formal notification of the action taken concerning University of Detroit Mercy by The Higher Learning Commission. At its meeting on June 25, 2007, the Institutional Actions Council (IAC) voted to continue the accreditation of University of Detroit Mercy, and to adopt any new items entered on the attached Statement of Affiliation Status (SAS). The Commission Board of Trustees validated the IAC action through its validation process that concluded on July 11, 2007. The date on this letter constitutes the effective date of your new status with the Commission.

I have enclosed your institution's *Statement of Affiliation Status (SAS)* and *Organizational Profile (OP)*. The SAS is a summary of your organization's ongoing relationship with the Commission. The OP is generated from data you provided in your most recent, (2005-06) Annual Institutional Data Update. Accreditation at the doctoral level is limited to the Juris Doctorate (J.D.); the Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology; the Doctor of Engineering (DEng) in Civil and Environmental Engineering, Electrical and Computer Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering; and the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP). Out-of-state degree offerings are limited to the Toledo, Ohio nursing program.

Approval of New Degree Locations:

The Commission is applying changes to stipulations for notification of location approval to align with the Institutional Change Policy. Some institutions are currently under review to ensure conformity with the policies. This entry will be updated in the coming months following completion of that review.

Approval of Distance and Correspondence Courses and Programs:

The institution has been approved under Commission policy to offer up to 5% of its total degree programs through distance education. The processes for expanding distance education are defined in other Commission documents.
