

Understanding South Dakota's **Gold Card** **CONCEALED CARRY**

WEAPON PERMIT

As of January 2017, the Gold Card is an optional permit that will allow approved permit holders the ability to present the permit to a retailer when purchasing a firearm, in lieu of a National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) and leave with the firearm. The card proves passage of the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) background check on the spot.

Benefits

- Purchase exemption
- Concealed carry within South Dakota
- Reciprocity with 32 states (Includes the 31 states that recognize the regular permit plus Wisconsin)

Requirements

- Apply with your County Sheriff
- Completion of a FBI fingerprint background check, including fee of \$43.25 to DCI for processing
- Authorization to conduct the fingerprint background check
- Application fee of \$70 for permit
- Card holders are subject to Periodic NICS background checks to ensure continued eligibility

Renewal

- Every five years, with renewal fee of \$70 for permit
- Can renew 90 days prior to expiration
- Renewal includes FBI fingerprint background check with fee of \$43.25 to DCI for processing

A person does not need a permit to own a pistol, keep it in his home, business, or property, or visibly carry it (SDCL 22-14-11).

A new or renewed Permit to Carry a Concealed Pistol may be obtained from the sheriff of the county which the applicant is a resident (SDCL 23-7-7).

Understanding South Dakota's **Enhanced** CONCEALED CARRY

WEAPON PERMIT

The Enhanced Permit gives South Dakota residents greater reciprocity and recognition in states such as Minnesota and Nebraska that have stricter concealed weapon requirements. In NE and MN an individual must be 21 years of age and have an Enhanced Permit to carry concealed.

As of January 2017, the Enhanced Permits issued on or after 01/01/2017 is an optional permit that will allow approved permit holders the ability to present the permit to a retailer when purchasing a firearm, in lieu of a National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) and leave with the firearm. The card proves passage of the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) background check on the spot.

Benefits

- Purchase exemption
- Concealed carry within South Dakota
- Recognition for concealed carry within 31 other states (same as the Regular Permit)
- Additional recognition for concealed carry within 6 more states including MN and NE

Requirements

- Apply with your County Sheriff
- Certification of completion of qualifying handgun course, which includes use of force training, basic concepts, self-defense principles and live fire training
- Completion of a FBI fingerprint background check including fee of \$43.25 to DCI for processing
- Authorization to conduct the fingerprint background check
- Application fee of \$100 for permit
- Card holders issued on or after 01/01/2017 are subject to periodic NICS background checks to ensure continued eligibility

Renewal

- Every five years, with renewal fee of \$50 if renewed between 90 days prior and 30 days after expiration. If renewed more than 30 days after expiration, renewal fee is \$100 and the qualifying handgun course must be completed again
- Renewal includes FBI fingerprint background check with fee of \$43.25 to DCI for processing
